Logical Reasoning Project- "If You Give a Mouse a Cookie"

Objective: To write and illustrate children's book using a logical chain, similar to "If You Give a Mouse a Cookie."

Requirements:

- ➤ A logical chain storybook with at least 10 conditional statements (If...., then....)
- > Create a storybook with an appropriate storyline that is illustrated and easy to read.

This is an individual project. It is a TEST GRADE. Technology may be used to create your book.

This is an **OPTIONAL** project and will be due on **September 30th (A day)** or **October 1st (B day)** and will be worth 1 test grade.
